




Through a community of devoted volunteers from the local church, Safe Families for Children creates extended family–like supports for families in crisis to keep children safe and families intact.

This ministry is volunteer-driven, professionally supported. Family Coaches and Safe Families staff work alongside parents in need as they formulate goals and work towards stability.

Your church can partner in the following ways, your investment of:

Tier 1:

\$1,500 provides the resources to help families across Cleveland: We provide your church with 2 Learning Modules per year

Learning Module 1: Positive Parenting Principles

With so many books on parenting out there- what do you choose? This LM will begin with a biblical foundation of parenting and integrate research-based child rearing principles that will help you gain greater understanding of child development and increase your connection with your children.

Learning Module 2: Child Protection with Purpose

God's word is clear on the importance of protecting the vulnerable. It is very important for the church to understand how to prevent and recognize child maltreatment. This LM will cover implications for creating a plan for church-wide child protection as well as how to recognize and report child abuse and neglect.

Learning Module 3: Creating a Culture of Biblical Hospitality

Move over Martha Stewart! Hospitality of the Bible is radical and goes beyond coffee and pastries. This LM will demonstrate how hospitality was a critical component of the early church and how we need to resurrect this practice in our churches today.

Learning Module 4: Rethinking Poverty

Everyone wants to break cycles of poverty but we must see that we too are poor. This LM will challenge you personally and as a church by bringing together a variety of resources that help us develop a heart of compassion, move beyond modes of relief, and into an understanding of dignity.

Learning Module 5: Cat & Dog Theology (UnveilinGlory)

A unique Scripture-based way of communicating the need for Christians to re-think their relationship with their Master (God). The purpose of Cat and Dog Theology is to call the global church away from its self-centeredness and to focus on the glory of God.
